



Rules of the Club

All affairs of Chorley Tennis Club are the responsibility of the Management Committee supported by the Tennis Committee and the Development Committee.

Categories of membership and annual subscription rates are set by the Management Committee at the Annual General Meeting. Minutes of this and other Management Committee meetings are available on request from the Club Secretary.

Membership fees are due on the 1st April. Any member not having paid his or her annual membership by 31st May will no longer be regarded as a member of the Club and as such will not be able to use the Club facilities or play in any of the Club teams until full payment is made.

New members must pay by April 15th to be eligible to play for teams.

Where the conduct of any member is considered not to be in the interests of the Club the Management Committee will take appropriate action.

Members are allowed to introduce visitors to the Club under their personal responsibility subject to Club byelaws and regulations. Visitors are allowed a maximum of three visits before membership is required.

Members shall at all times act in accordance with Club policies on conduct, child protection, health and safety and wear appropriate clothing and footwear as occasions demand.

Copies of Club policies and contact details of Club officials will be made available in the Clubhouse or can be obtained on request from the Club Secretary.
