



Definitions of Club Membership Categories

- 1) **Senior Member:** Adult aged over 18 (see footnote), who may play all year round at all times, subject to organised Club events having court priority. A Senior Member may play for Club teams if selected, may receive coaching and play in intra club competitions, (all subject to additional fees).
- 2) **New Senior Member:** Adult aged over 18 (see footnote), who has all the benefits of a Senior Member, but qualifies for a discounted rate of membership for the first year. An individual may not apply for the new senior membership category if she or he has already been a member of the Club within the previous 3 years.
- 3) **Family Membership:** Applies to a family unit which has all the benefits of senior and/or junior members. Any question of eligibility in this category will be decided by the Membership Secretary.
- 4) **New Family Membership:** Have all the benefits of a Family Membership, but qualifies for a discounted rate of membership for the first year only. A family may not apply for the new family membership category if they have held family membership within the previous 3 years.
- 5) **Junior/Intermediate (11-18) & Primary School Junior** (see footnote): Members in both these age groups are able to play all year round at all times apart from when other organised club events take priority. They can play for teams if selected, in intra Club competitions and receive coaching (all subject to additional fees).
- 6) **Student (18+):** Adult aged over 18 (see footnote), who may play all year round at all times, subject to organised Club events having court priority. A Student (18+) may play for teams if selected, may receive coaching and play in intra Club competitions (all subject to additional fees). They must be in full time education on 1st April of the year when membership payment is due.
- 7) **Student (18+) whose term time address is out of area:** Adult aged over 18 (see footnote), who have all the benefits of a Student (18+) Member. They must be both in full time education and living away from home on 1st April of the year when membership payment is due.

- 8) **Retired Member:** Have all the benefits of a Senior Member. This applies only to adults aged 60 or over (see footnote) who have left full time employment.
- 9) **Unemployed Member:** Have all the benefits of a Senior Member. He or she must be unemployed on 1st April of the year of membership and also must be in receipt of Job Seeker's Allowance. Proof may be required by the Membership Secretary.
- 10) **Day Time (to 4pm week-days):** Adults aged 18 or over (see footnote) who may only play on a social basis between 12am and 4pm, Monday to Friday (excluding Bank Holidays) when there are no Club events that otherwise will take priority. They are not eligible for team selection, intra Club competitions or membership coaching.
